Does the institution limit participation in various activities if the student is on probation?

Institutions	Policies
Asuza	For our Continued on Probation—Readmitted by Petition students, there is a limitation beyond the academic unit restriction. These students should not work more than 10 hours per week (on and off campus). Of course there might be individualized situations that would warrant additional (or a waiver) of these restrictions. It is not uncommon for the Review Committee to mandate that a student not participate as an Orientation Leader, restrict their membership in musical or theatrical productions, and so forth.
Biola	
Claremont	We require our students on probation to complete 4 full courses (16 semester hours) for 4 letter grades and meet the GPA requirements to return to good standing. Otherwise, we do not restrict their activities in any other way.
Gordon	Students must maintain satisfactory academic progress to participate in intercollegiate athletics sponsored by the College or to be eligible for a class office, a co-op placement or other privileges
Harvey Mudd	Harvey Mudd College does not allow students on academic probation to participate in intercollegiate athletics. Students do have the right to appeal to the Scholarly Standing Committee for release from probation prior to the end of the semester. While approval of such a request is rare, the decision of the Committee would be based on performance indicators (i.e. mid-term exams).
La Verne	We do not limit student activities or participation in sports when they are placed on academic probation. We do limit the number of credits a student can enroll once they are on probation. Once a student is on probation they can enroll in 14 semester hours or less. We also notify their academic advisors to make sure they are aware the student is on probation. We encourage the advisors to meet with the students to carefully choose their courses, repeat courses if needed, and hopefully at that time talk about time management. We find in many of the cases this is the problem, especially working too many hours a week.

Occidental	
Pepperdine	When somebody is on probation, we strongly encourage them to limit their extra-curricular activities, but it is not something we officially mandate. Having said that, please know that students must be in good standing to participate in International Programs or to apply to be Resident Advisors or Student Life Advisors on our campus. Athletic requirements are tied to NCAA and it is possible, though rare, for someone to be on academic probation and also be eligible to participate.
Pitzer	
Pomona	We don't normally restrict extra-curriculars.....we'd do that only if the specific case suggested that curbing involvements was appropriate.
Pt. Loma	Students on academic probation are limited to 13 units, may not study abroad, are ineligible for NAIA competition, are not allowed to hold a major office in ASB or represent PLNU in most co-curricular events for which academic eligibility is a requirement
Redlands	They do not approve athletic participation for students who are on probation and other organizations will check GPAS before students are allowed to participate, especially in sororities and fraternities. Students can petition to participate in a sport if they are on probation and some are approved.
Scripps	Students are not eligible to hold student body office or to serve as a Residence Hall Adviser. They may not participate on athletic teams unless they are specifically approved to do so by petition to the Committee on Academic Review.
Seattle Pacific	
Wheaton	Cannot participate in athletics. Participation in leadership positions will be subject to the approval of the Student Development Office
