You may need to tap 'OK' to allow Authenticator to scan a QR code with the Camera. Once the camera is working, hold the phone up to the computer screen to scan the QR code. A 6-digit code will appear in the app when complete. If using only your phone, you will need to reveal and copy the setup key instead of scanning the QR code. Once at this screen, switch back to the browser app where the QR code appeared. Skip the next two pages and continue on page 10.





5 Enter the 6-digit code beneath the QR code on the computer's browser. The code in the app will change every thirty seconds, flashing red briefly before each change. If the code is about to change, it's best to wait for the new one to appear before entering it. ⁽⁶⁾Press the 'Continue' button at the bottom of the page when done.

DO NOT use your Westmont account. The codes will disappear immediately if your Westmont password changes, and IT will need to reset Authenticator for you.
