



2022 Summer Internship Program

When: June 11-August 13, 2022 (beginning right after Westmont Mayterm so as to afford students the opportunity to do Mayterm plus this summer program toward advanced class standing/graduating a semester early)

Where: The Westmont in San Francisco house—a 4-story residence located at 3016 Jackson Street in the Pacific Heights neighborhood of the City. For a virtual tour of the facility go to <https://my.matterport.com/show/?m=3VsJQK3btjX>

Program Cost and Financial Aid: \$5,950. The program cost includes tuition for up to 8 units of internship credit and housing costs as well as full kitchen privileges at the Jackson Street House for the nine-week program. Residency is required and students will be responsible for purchasing their own food. As a summer session program financial aid is not available. However, the overall costs are substantially less than semester fees, providing students with an opportunity to gain advanced standing and/or to graduate early resulting in significant backend financial savings. A limited number of \$500 scholarships are available (application required). Roughly budget an additional \$1,200 for transportation, food, and incidental expenses.

Core Curriculum: The Westmont in San Francisco summer program incorporates the required 8-unit, 36 hours per week Internship course (**IS 190: WSF Internship (8 units) Open to All Majors**) and its companion seminar class “Values and Vocation.” Students may also register for one additional Independent Studies tutorial via WSF or pre-approved class at San Francisco City College or other approved institutions for up to 4 additional units. The internship is a 36-hour per week local supervised internship within a variety of placement sites representing a broad range of majors and student interests along with a weekly companion seminar. Students may receive 4-8 units of major credit (departments vary in this regard) for the internship course. Students are responsible for covering the costs of additional courses.

Application & Admission: Open to students of all majors, First Years through Seniors, who submit their application by the **January 15, 2021** deadline. Late applications may be accepted as space allows. Admission is selective and priority is given to juniors and seniors although first-year and sophomore students are encouraged to also apply early. Students must confirm their acceptance within 14 days of acceptance.

Criteria: Students must 1) maintain satisfactory academic standing (minimum GPA of 2.3) and student life standing; 2) receive the final dose of the Covid vaccine at least two weeks prior to the commencement of the program.
