- Campus Connections Committee (VP Grierson) - 7:35
  - Stickers redesigned for Campus Connections
- Westmont Beautification committee (CM Brase) - 7:40
  - Wooden v. GLC tables
    - Wooden are more cost efficient, able to be shipped more quickly even if more breakable
    - Choosing square tables over round tables since they are cheaper
    - Possibly increase number of chairs
    - Meeting with the subcommittee one more time to solidify plans
- Meeting with Baccalaureate Committee (President Good)
  - Smaller graduation service is possible, in the works tentatively
  - Student speakers and hymns for the service
  - Possibility of renting out the drive in theater for graduation service
  - Decent chance of a virtual graduation service
    - No orchestra or choir present
  - Minimize who needs to be there in person
- Meeting with Jason (BM Chan) - 7:45
  - Increase of cases this past week, classify as an outbreak
    - Is an outbreak, 2-3 cases or more is considered an outbreak
    - Increases fear, doesn't like to use it
  - How are people getting infected?
    - Someone came back and tested on the 8th, tested positive and went to gathering with 9 people, they exposed other (why mail was closed)
    - MLK people went off campus to IV
    - People were not reporting their symptoms
    - Able to pinpoint how students got sick, not from athletes or outdoors

- Coming from large gathering
- What point would Westmont have to lockdown?
  - Cannot send people home, would have to keep people in rooms, only food or bathroom, Zoom for classes
  - In case that there were no resources for isolating people or delivering food
- Putting numbers of quarantined people and cases on the website
  - Not helpful to put quarantined numbers
  - Does not reflect the number of positive cases
  - Sending out an email
- Rapid PCR test available now
- People can get tested off campus if they would like
- Isolation
  - 10 days in isolation
  - On tenth day if you have no fever for 24 hours, you can go free and don't need to be tested
  - People are known to test positive three months after getting covid
  - Some symptoms: mild cough, etc. but you are not contagious at that point
  - If bad symptoms continue, then they need to contact the Health Center
- No hospitalizations, but some visits to the hospital
- Quarantine
  - Only quarantining second degree contact, don't want that advertised widely because people may try to get out of quarantine by lying
  - Try to separate if there is a roommate that has not been exposed
  - Exposed person quarantines 5 days and then gets tested
- Vaccine roll out
  - No information yet
  - County has been slow with vaccine rollout
- Communication
  - Videos being released for the past couple of weeks
  - Talk to Nancy Phinney or Irene Neller about communicating about COVID
  - Direct people to the link for Jason's videos
- Weekly Email
  - More than happy to do that, or admin to do it
  - If need more information, Jason could talk to Beebe and they could put out a statement about quarantine
  - Might be more impactful coming from students- is it our place to send out information?
  - Possible chapel update each Friday

- Video of encouragement to students to persevere to the end
- Might be better to have Westmont Communications or admin
- Kenna will talk to Irene Neller, and send out a preliminary email and going to chapel
  - Jason pushed for video for students, posting on Instagram?
- Sarah, Andrea, Kenna, Noah, and Hannah can coordinate for future messaging
